## ACCOMMODATION

LOC strongly recommends booking accommodation for athletes, team officials and staff through the accommodation office, contact person Ms. Mirjam Žerjav, email: [mirjam.zerjav@sloski.si](mailto:mirjam.zerjav@sloski.si). Only in this case will the teams be fully supported by additional LOC services (transportation between the official hotels and the venue, organized catering at the venue). All official hotels are flexible in serving daily meals (breakfast, dinner).

### IMPORTANT DATES (DEADLINES)

LOC is kindly asking all teams to send the accommodation request until **30/11/2023 the latest**. It must include the following provisional information: date of arrival, date of departure, number of participants, number of double/twin and single rooms. The number of single rooms is limited.

The LOC will book accommodation for teams after receiving the accommodation request. LOC will prepare a proforma invoice, which must be paid in advance. **The 90% advance payment is required to secure the booking. The advance payment must be paid latest until 15/12/2023.**

**The rest 10% payment is required the latest 7 days before the arrival of the team.**

Preliminary entry deadline: **30/11/2023. The preliminary entry counts as a booking.**

The final number of the team members must be provided the latest **January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024.**

### CANCELLATION POLICY

The booking can be cancelled free of charge until **30/11/2023**.

After **1/12/2023** until **28/1/2024** a change in number of rooms +/- 10% is allowed free of charge (FIS Rules, Art. 13.3.2).

Cancellation of hotel rooms after **28/1/2024** or no show will be charged with a **100% fee**.

### THE HOTELS

The LOC offers 20 hotels for the official team accommodations:

- 12 hotels in destination Kranjska Gora, Slovenia
- 3 hotels in destination Tarvisio, Italy
- 5 hotels in destination Faaker See, Austria

The LOC will allocate the teams according to the booking registration immediately after receiving the booking registration - deadline at the end of November 2023. The teams will be contacted by LOC accommodation coordinator Mrs. Mirjam Žerjav, [mirjam.zerjav@sloski.si](mailto:mirjam.zerjav@sloski.si).

Early team registrations will be given priority, but teams will not be able to request specific hotels.

The cost for accommodation and full board (three meals per day) will be charged:

- In **4\* hotels** CHF 100 per person per day in a double room. The number of single rooms at this price is limited according to FIS Rules, Art. 13.3. Supplement for single room or single use over quota will be charged CHF 30 per person per day.
- In **3\* hotels** CHF 90 per person per day in a double room. The number of single rooms at this price is limited according to FIS Rules, Art. 13.3. Supplement for single rooms or single use over quota will be charged CHF 30 per person per day.
- In apartments price will be defined according to teams' requests and availability.

Since the LOC needs to pre-pay the accommodation, teams will be required to pay a deposit of **90%** the latest until **15/12/2023**. An invoice will be sent to teams based on their booking information. Please note that accommodations will be assigned to teams once payment has been received.

LOC will provide for teams free shuttle service from official hotels to the venue and back upon request.

## OFFICIAL DESTINATIONS AND ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

*Destination Kranjska Gora, Gozd Martuljek and near villages in Slovenia; approx. 15 minutes drive from the venue:*

An alpine destination that boasts some incredible natural features and various excellent accommodation options at the 4\* and 3\* hotels and apartment houses. There are various superb accommodations to choose from, all of which provide services of the highest quality.

*Destination Tarvisio; approx. 20 minutes drive from the venue:*

Located near border in Italy offers accommodation in different 4\* and 3\* hotels.

*Destination Faaker See; approx. 35 minutes drive from the venue:*

Located near border in Austria offers accommodation in different 4\* and 3\* hotels.

LOC reserves the right to prepare accommodation plan for teams according to organizational needs and transportation possibilities.

## MEALS

Lunch will be served to all athletes, officials and team staff at the venue (no lunch service will be provided in the hotels). It will be mandatory to do the prebooking through LOC accreditation system.

**Teams booking their own accommodation are not entitled to free meals at the venue. If requested, lunch will be available for purchase.**

The OC will organize lunch for all teams at the venue starting from Saturday, **3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024** on. Lunches on days prior to the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024 starting from Wednesday, 1<sup>st</sup> February 2024 will be available on request.

Breakfast and dinner service will either be catered in the hotels or in a central hotel location within walking distance from the hotels.

More details of the food plan will be provided to all teams closer to the event.

### TRANSPORTATION SERVICE DURING THE EVENT

The LOC will provide a shuttle service free of charge upon request between Planica venue and the OC official team hotels.

**Teams booking their own accommodation are responsible to arrange their own transportation. The OC does not have to provide a shuttle service for these teams. (FIS Rules 13.2)**

## PRELIMINARY ENTRY FOR TEAMS

To submit the preliminary entry for the FIS Nordic Junior / U23 Cross-Country World Ski Championships Planica 2024 for NSA, please use the FIS online entry system where you will complete your preliminary entry, which also counts as a booking.

The deadline for the preliminary entry is **30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**.

## FINAL ENTRIES

The final entry for each competition must be done in the race office until 2 hours before the respective Team Captains Meeting.

In case of "force majeure" the Jury may permit a substitute to be entered in place of another athlete after the first team captains' meeting. (art. 12.4.)

## WAX CABINS AND WAX ROOMS

Wax cabins will be provided at the venue according to the technical regulations in the FIS Nordic Junior / U23 Cross-Country World Ski Championships Rules.

The Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined wax cabins will be located at the Ski Jumping team area and will be available from Sunday, **4<sup>th</sup> February 2024** on.

Cross-Country and Nordic Combined (Cross-Country) wax cabins will be located at the Cross-Country Wax Area, next to the Ski Flying Hill. The CC Wax Area will be opened from Saturday, **3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024** on.

Cross-Country venue will be officially open for training on Saturday, **3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024**.

Wax cabins must be registered by **30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**.

### Prices for additional wax cabins:

Single cabin (approx. 6 x 2,4 m) Euro 1.500, - (excl. VAT)

Invoice must be paid until **15<sup>th</sup> January 2024**.

### Service Industry

The LOC offers wax cabins for SRS in Cross Country wax area.

## WAX TRUCKS

At the Planica venue one (1) wax vehicle/truck per team with maximum dimension 20 x 10 meters when extended, will have permission to park.

Teams need to register their wax vehicle/truck with the preliminary entry by **30<sup>th</sup> November 2023**.

All wax vehicle/trucks will be located at the Cross-Country wax area. Team arriving with wax trucks are not entitled to a wax cabin.

Wax trucks arrival to the venue will be possible from **Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024, 9:00 hours on**.

## TEAM RADIOS (REGULATIONS OF RADIO EQUIPMENT / RADIO FREQUENCIES)

Please note that radio equipment may only be used with the permission (licence) of the Agency for communication networks and services of the Republic of Slovenia (AKOS) and/or according to the Radio Equipment Directive (RED - 2014/53/EU) - general authorisation (harmonized usage in EU).

Anyone planning to use radio frequency equipment in Slovenia needs to fill out a form (or forms) in order to apply for a permit. You can find the forms on following links:

The deadline for frequency applications for the FIS Nordic Junior/U23 Cross-Country World Ski Championships Planica 2024 is 42 days before the event, namely **25<sup>th</sup> December 2023**.

All radio equipment must have a CE mark (that it can be used in EU) according to the Radio Equipment Directive (RED - 2014/53/EU).

**Important:** It is not allowed to set up and use private Wi-Fi networks or similar and/or other non-authorised devices operating in the 2.4 and 5 GHz frequency bands within the venue in Planica.

## ACCREDITATION AND COMPETITION OFFICE

### ACCREDITATION OFFICE

Accreditation Office will be located in Hotel Kompas in Kranjska Gora.

To obtain an accreditation for the FIS Nordic Junior / U23 Cross-Country World Ski Championships Planica 2024 it is mandatory for all participants to register through OC Planica Accreditation System.

The registration must be done via following link:

The system will be open from **8/1/2024** on.

Obligatory information for every participant is their first and last name, a current photo on which the face is clearly visible, date of birth and their function.

Accreditations will be in use and must always be worn visibly from **4<sup>th</sup> February 2024** onwards at all venues in Planica.

Should the accreditation be lost or stolen, notification must be made immediately to the accreditation office at the Hotel Kompas. The fee for issuing a new accreditation is 50 €. Misuse of accreditation will be prosecuted.

### COMPETITION OFFICES

Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined (Ski Jumping) Competition Office will be located at the Ski Jumping team area.

Cross-Country and Nordic Combined (Cross-Country) Competition Office will be located at the Cross-Country team area.

Working hours of both Competition Offices will be defined closer to the event.

## TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING, MEDAL CEREMONIES, INSURANCE

### TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING

All Team Captains Meetings will take place at the Planica venue. The exact location will be defined at later stage.

### MEDAL CEREMONIES

The medal ceremonies will be held immediately after each competition for the top 6 athletes and 3 best teams.

Locations:

- Ski Jumping stadium (Ski Jumping)
- Cross Country stadium (Cross Country and Nordic Combined)

### INSURANCE

All athletes and team officials have to be insured by their own NSA. All participants have to be covered by an adequate insurance policy for medical costs, accidents, injury, illness and civil liability. The organizer is not responsible for covering their own health care costs, including in cases of emergency.

## CEREMONIES

The Opening Ceremony will take place at the venue on **4<sup>th</sup> February 2024**.

The Closing Ceremony will take place at the venue, immediately after the last Ski Jumping event on Sunday, **February 11, 2024**.

## SUMMARY OF FIS RULES

### 12.1 FIS online registration system

Entries (provisional team selection, final team entry) must be made by NSAs in the FIS online registration system. Entries made by email, fax or paper will not be accepted.

### 12.2 Preliminary entry

Each National Ski Association must send to the Organising Committee the preliminary entry with the number of competitors, coaches and service staff according to 6.1 by November 30<sup>th</sup> latest.

**Important:** Preliminary entries are mandatory for all the teams.

#### Late entry

After the deadline the FIS online registration remains open, however, the LOC is not obliged to arrange accommodation for the NSA, which makes the late entry.

### 12.3 Entry by name

All the participating NSAs must send their entries by names through the online registration system. The system will be opened for entry by name as soon as the preliminary entry has been done.

Entries by name will be used by the LOC to prepare accreditations and to prepare the final entry list.

Change of names will still be possible until the day before the first TCM (23:59 CET). After the deadline the system will be closed and any changes of the names are only possible after the approval from the respective Jury.

### 12.4 Final entries

The final entry for each competition has to be done in the race office until 2 hours before the respective Team Captains Meeting.

Only competitors from the final entry by name (see article 12.3) can be chosen.

Replacement of Competitors after the first TCM In case of "force majeure" the Jury may permit a substitute to be entered in place of another athlete after the first team captains' meeting.

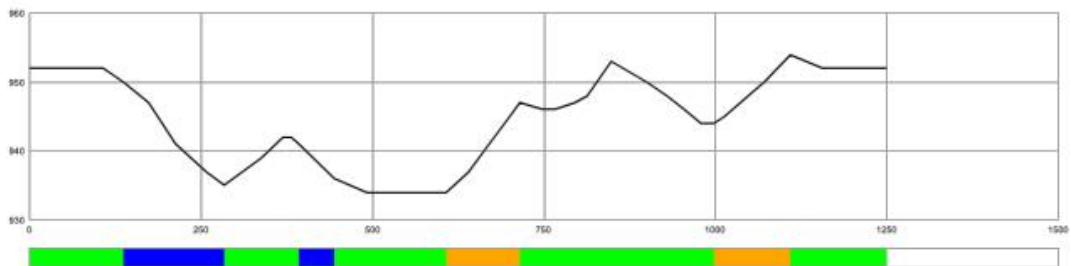
